# QUESTIONS TO PONDER (YOUNGERS):

- Are you a Doubting Thomas sort of person?
- Do you believe what others tell you?
- Or do you need to see proof?

🧚 Before Thomas is with them, Jesus "breathed" on the other disciples, so that they could continue his

work. What do you think this felt like to the disciples?

# QUESTIONS TO PONDER (OLDER):

- Where do you think Thomas was when the other disciples who had gathered saw Jesus? Would you have believed the word of the other disciples without actually seeing Jesus?
- When Thomas is able to touch Jesus' wounds, he finally believes. We are asked to believe without being able to "see" or "touch" Jesus. Do you find this hard?
- Are there times when it is especially hard for you to believe in God? Jesus? What is the role of the Holy Spirit in this for you?



#### THINGS TO DO:

- Watch a video about Easter and don't worry the details too much

- Play I Doubt It: Each player prepares by looking for items that can be counted. These could be easy or hard, but you'll need to know the exact number. (Of spoons in the kitchen? Of crayons? Of towel bars? Of some kind of toy? Your mom's pairs of shoes? Of someone's socks?) Have at least

three items written down on a

piece of paper for yourself with the proper number. Take turns having others guess the number of an item. Guesses must increase with each turn. Anyone may shout out "I DOUBT IT!" if they think a guess is too high, but if they're wrong, they're out for the rest of the round. Whoever is right gets a point. Winner gets something wonderful like first pick of any leftover jellybeans from last Sunday.

- Finjoy the Rembrandt painting below. In this picture, Jesus is shown as a gardener. Why do you think that is? Does that image work for you?
- Get outside and take a moment of quiet: In the early part of our Doubting Thomas story, Jesus

breathed on the apostles and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." He has given them the ability to bless and forgive, just as He can. Go outside and find a nice quiet place to sit by yourself for a few minutes. Take a deep breath. Breath in and out as you think of all of your blessings. Can you feel the Holy Spirit working around and within you?

- Spend some time at the table: Share a time when you or someone in your family was really doubted by everyone around them, and they proved everyone wrong! Or share a time when you or someone in your family doubted someone else, and you were wrong! Or share a time when you or someone in your family really doubted that they could do
